



Newberry/Harvard Property Owners Association Meeting Minutes

Saturday, April 14, 2018

The regular meeting of the NSHRPOA began at noon at the Newberry Springs Family Center.

A property tax presentation was given by Bob Vasseur describing the contents of local property tax bills as well as outlining property tax history before and after Proposition 13, and pointing out the property tax breaks available to many individuals and groups such as disabled, blind, elderly, and veterans. Bob agreed to write a short article on property taxes for the Family Center newsletter.

Discussion followed about the proposed Daggett and Newberry Springs solar plants with emphasis on the need for cooperation between historically incompatible community groups that is needed if a successful opposition movement is to be possible.

It was decided to pursue a small-claims suit against the NSEDA to recover funds taken from the Association during the so-called dissolution of 2016/17.

The meeting adjourned at about 1:30 p.m.
