It's more fun when children have a lot of stations to go to.

First, Second and Third place ribbons are awarded to the best decorated "Treat Station" in 3 categories.

- * **Covered Booth** = decorated tent, easy-up, motor home or framework
- * **Treat Table** = open decorated table (small or large)
- * **Trunk Treats** = Park on the south side of the ball field (Trunk-n-Treat Lane), back up to the grass and serve treats out of your decorated trunk. "Now that's easy!"

Get as elaborate as you want; wear costumes, play spooky music, play a game for treats, or just make it simple, it's the treats that are important. Plan on approx. 250 children (they will come by your station at least 3 times).

Set up as early as you like, treat stations must be in place by 5:45 PM.

Check-in Between 5:00 - 6:00 PM by the bleachers
